Do you realise that in asking to have your child baptised you accept responsibility to raise your child in the faith of the Catholic Church, observing the teachings of Jesus and the Church and observing the commandments to love God and your neighbour as Christ taught us?	
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Will you seriously undertake to fulfil this duty by word and example?
